Mayors' Institute on City Design

RESOURCE TEAM PARTICIPATION OVERVIEW

MICD Resource Team alumni are invited to indicate their interest in the MICD Alumni Technical Assistance program. The primary objective of the Resource Team member is to share their expertise with a mayor who is seeking to (1) continue their MICD case study project, or (2) work through a new city design challenge related to COVID recovery and/or racial justice in their city.

As a Resource Team member, you will do this by:

- Collaborating with your fellow Resource Team member to develop recommendations on the project. (Each mayor will be assigned a team of two Resource Team alumni.)
- Participating in a 60-minute scoping call with your assigned mayor to understand the project.
- Leading up to four 30-minute interview sessions with stakeholders identified by the mayor.
- Joining an informal networking call with Resource Teams who are concurrently advising other mayors and cities, to share ideas, approaches, and resources.
- Presenting your observations and recommendations back to the mayor in a 90-minute call, approximately 6 weeks after the kick-off scoping call.
- Participating in prep and check-in calls with MICD staff, as needed.
- Conducting some research or activation of networks, to help the mayor identify relevant models and good practices.

Time Commitment

The total time commitment is anticipated to be around 15-20 hours over approximately six weeks. Mayors and Resource Team members will be paired on a rolling basis beginning October 30, with the first projects expected to take place in November – December 2020.

Compensation

Each selected Resource Team member will receive an honorarium of \$5,000 upon the conclusion of the city engagement.

Eligibility

All MICD Resource Team alumni are invited to express their interest. MICD will match Resource Team alumni with mayors based on expertise needed as well as availability.
